

# Stroh Ranch Pool Rules

## OUTDOOR POOL RULES:

1. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.
2. Pool is for use by residents of Stroh Ranch and their guests only.
3. Shower before entering pool.
4. No dogs or other animals allowed in pool areas.
5. No glass containers allowed in or around the pool area.
6. No running, shoving, dunking, rough play or excessive noise is allowed in the pool or locker room area.
7. You must towel off and dry feet prior to entering recreation building.
8. No gum chewing allowed while swimming.
9. No one under 13 years of age is allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult.
10. No water guns allowed in the pool area.
11. Proper swimming attire is required. Swim suits only.
12. Smoking is not allowed in the pool area.
13. No hanging on lane/pool dividers
14. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in pool area.
15. Obey directions and instructions of lifeguard(s).

## POOL REGULATIONS:

1. Pool will be open Memorial Day to Labor Day.
2. Swim Lessons – As enrollment allows. See Recreation Center for details.
3. The staff is not responsible for any loss or theft of personal belongings.
4. The pool is available for private parties only after normal Recreation Center hours.
5. Swimmers are to supply their own towels and swim supplies.
6. Toddler wading pool is for children 6 and under, and each child **must** be accompanied by an adult at all times, even when a lifeguard is on duty; wading pool is not life guarded.
7. All guests must be accompanied by a resident. Guest fees subject to change with notice. Each household is allowed 5 guests per day. First two guests are free; guests 3, 4, and 5 are \$3.00 each.
8. Pool will be closed when air temperature is 60 degrees F and below, or when lightning is spotted or thunder is heard (20 minute rule applies).
9. All lifeguards reserve the right to remove anyone from the pool area who does not comply with the pool rules and regulations.
10. Additional rules and regulations may be implemented without notice at discretion of the Recreation Center Manager, who will always have a current copy of the updated rules.
